### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

We have a simple school uniform of blue sweatshirts and polo shirts with an embroidered school logo. There are also fleece jackets, sun hats and book bags for the children. We encourage all children to wear the uniform as it supports our school ethos, encouraging a sense of pride, belonging and equality in school whilst recognising each child as a valued individual.

Children are asked to bring named, indoor shoes to help keep the school clean and mud free! Please do not provide your child with large slippers for health and safety reasons.

Research indicates that water improves intellectual performance. For this reason the children bring named water bottles into school. Only water should be brought into school as part of our commitment to being a healthy school. We have chilled water dispensers, but they will only accommodate bottles of **16cm approx** in height. Larger water bottles may still be filled, but not with chilled water.
