Could I make a great King or Queen?

History

We will be finding out about the role of a monarch. The children will then be finding out about Queen Elizabeth 1st and Queen Victoria. Also, they will be comparing the lives of both monarchs.

Science

The children will be learning about animals including humans with a focus this half term on ourselves. They will learn about the senses, they will also learn to name the parts of the body. Year 2 will learn about the importance of hygiene, health and a balanced diet.

Maths

The children will be developing their knowledge of place value and number order. They shall also be looking at 2D shape and be able to name them and describe their properties. The children will continue to practise writing number in both words and numerals..

Year 1 are expected by the end of the year to write numbers 1-20 in numerals and **words**.

Year 2 are expected by the end of the year to write numbers to at **least 100** in numerals and **words**.
